 Quinn Kirsch, who died suddenly of Myocarditis on January 7, 2013
- All proceeds benefit the Myocarditis Foundation, which is dedicated to providing education and support related to the causes, symptoms, diagnosis and treatment of Myocarditis and sudden death
- In three years the event has raised and donated over \$65,000 to the Myocarditis Foundation in honor of Quinn
- Over 550 mite & squirt skaters from Edina & surrounding communities participated in 2016 at Centennial Lakes. Hundreds of parents, fans & spectators enjoyed food, music and hockey
- Quinn's Cup is a FUN event that emphasizes the love of outdoor hockey, celebrates Quinn & raises funds for a great cause
- Cost of entry is \$250/team for an 8-12 player team
